Information is provided to the court in the form of a certificate in accordance with *Section 10F Restraining Order Act 1997*. After notification of completion, applicants seeking to view the documents will need to apply to the relevant court.

Information included in the Police Information Certificate:

- Details of the respondent's criminal history (Certified History for Court Document).
- Police Orders made against the respondent.
- Details of Incident Reports (IR) relating to family violence, personal violence and exposure to children to such acts involving the respondent.
